Accommodation

shared

- Four students share a condo-style residence suite
- Each suite features two twin bedrooms, each with its own full ensuite bath (ratio of 2 per ensuite)
- Each suite also offers a living area, kitchenette and study space, as well as amazing mountain views
- Boys and girls are accommodated separately and placed according to age
- Counsellors reside on each residence floor providing supervision

Meals

full board

- 3 meals are served daily
- All meals are served in the university dining hall, and feature a choice of meal options and full salad bar

ESL Language Programme

15 hours/week

- 1 hour = 60 minutes
- Maximum of 15 students per class - internationally mixed
- Professional, qualified instructors
- Communicative methodologies for fast learning results
- English level placement test on first day
- 4 levels of ESL - from beginner to advanced
