Summer Homestay provides students with both a linguistic and cultural experience. Situated in Montréal, one of Canada's largest cities, our City Homestay Programme is the perfect fit for students who are looking for a complete French or English language immersion experience and who appreciate the comfort of ending their day with a home-cooked meal in a friendly family environment. Classes are taken in a modern language school, while evenings and weekends allow for family fun and social interaction.

- 2-7 week sessions - July & August
- English and/or French language study
- Bilingual (French/English) Experience possible
- 15 hours of language instruction per week
- Afternoon Activities + 1 Full Day Excursion per week
- Cultural immersion into life with a Canadian family
- ILSC campus is now located in a historic building in the heart of charming Old Montréal

Accommodation private room

- Private bedroom in the home of a Canadian host family
- Host families are recruited based on their desire to welcome students into their homes as members of the family
- Rooms have a bed, closet, and dresser, with workspace available either in the room or in a quiet place in the home
- Bathrooms are usually shared with the family, although some homes may provide private facilities
- Students have access to other common areas of the house
- English or French (as requested) is the spoken language in the home

Meals full board

- 3 meals are provided daily by the family
- Breakfast and supper are eaten at home, together as a family when possible
- The host provides a nutritious and well balanced packed lunch to take to school Monday through Friday

ESL or FSL Language Programme 15 hours/week

- 1 hour = 55 minutes
- Maximum of 14 students per class - internationally mixed
- Professional, qualified instructors
- Communicative methodologies for fast learning results
- Placement test on first day

Due to the bilingual nature of the Montréal programme, students must select their language of study. If a bilingual experience is requested, classes will be offered in one language, while host accommodation will be in the other.

- Large, well-equipped classrooms
- Computers with internet connection

- Student lounges
- Laundry facilities available in the home

SUNDAYS:

Students spend time with their host family on Sundays, practicing their English or French and learning about life in Canada. Together they may enjoy recreational activities around the home or in the city including: local summer festivals, recreation and sports or shopping.

Standard, or International, French is the standard of French dictionaries and higher education, and the main register for the press, television and radio broadcasting in addition to government and business-related communication. Although students may hear local colloquial 'Québécois' speech while in the city, all language instructors ensure that only the international style is used.

Programme Package includes:

- 15 hours ESL or FSL per week with materials
- Accommodation with host family
- 3 meals daily
- 5 afternoon activities /excursions per week
- 1 Full Day excursion operated each Saturday
- Montréal airport meet & greet + transfer to/from campus

Students may choose at time of application if they wish to live with a French speaking, English speaking or bilingual family.
