 - *Standard English:* 20 hours of ESL weekly
 - *Intensive English:* 20 hours of Standard ESL + 5 hours intensive ESL weekly

- Card-operated laundry

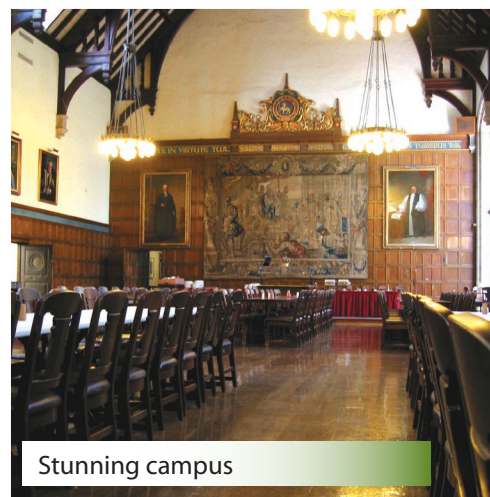

Learning Beyond the Classroom

As a complement to the core language programme, students may expand on their morning classes through a variety of optional activities. Options include opportunities to explore Toronto, visit famous sites, get together with other students, enjoy a pub night and truly experience "campus life." Staff prepare a calendar of events each week. Minimal fees apply.

CLASS FIELD TRIPS:

Teachers build upon class lessons through practical application and visits to local places of interest. Offered 1 afternoon (approximately 2 hours) per week. *Minimal fees apply for admission or public transit.*

CONVERSATION LUNCHES:

Informal yet effective, students gather over lunch with their teacher and class for a lively English-only discussion of various topics and current events. Takes place 1 lunch period each week.
